INSCRIPTION ON NORDIC PILLAR AT MOUNT ANTHOR:

Let them quake and fear at the death of their captain. And let those who perished upon this field find haven in Sovengarde. Let [Yngol](#), son of Ysgrammor, be avenged. This menheir was carved by Corragan...”
